CRIME #1: CRIMINAL DEVIATE CONDUCT (IC 35-42-2-2) Knowingly or intentionally causing another person to perform or submit to deviate sexual conduct.

CRIME #2: CHILD MOLESTING (IC 35-42-4-3) Performing or submitting to deviate sexual conduct on a child.

CRIME #3: CHILD EXPLOITATION (IC 35-42-4-4) Knowingly or intentionally presenting, exhibiting, photographing, or disseminating matter that depicts or describes sexual conduct by a child.

CRIME #4: VICARIOUS SEXUAL GRATIFICATION (IC 35-42-4-6) – Knowingly or intentionally directing, aiding, inducing, or causing a child to engage in deviate sexual conduct with another person or with an animal, to arouse sexual desires of the child or the adult.

CRIME #5: CHILD SOLICITATION (IC 35-42-4-6) Knowingly or intentionally soliciting a child to engage in deviate sexual conduct or any touching to arouse sexual desires of the child or the adult.

CRIME #6: CHILD SEDUCTION (IC 35-42-4-7). Engaging in deviate sexual conduct with a child.

CRIME #7: SEXUAL BATTERY (IC 35-42-4-8) – Compelling a person to submit to sexual touching by force or imminent threat of force.

CRIME #8: SEXUAL MISCONDUCT WITH A MINOR (IC 35-42-4-9) – Touching a child to arouse sexual desires of the child or the adult.

CRIME #9: INCEST (IC 35-46-1-3) Engaging in deviate sexual conduct with a relative.

CRIME #10: NEGLECT OF A DEPENDENT (IC 35-46-1-4) – Knowingly or intentionally endangering the life or health of a child, or cruelly confining a child.

CRIME #11: VOYEURISM (IC 35-45-4-5) Knowingly or intentionally looking in a prying or clandestine way, with or without a camera or video camera.

CRIME #12: CRIMINAL RECKLESSNESS (IC 35-42-2-2) – Recklessly, knowingly, or intentionally performing an act that creates a substantial risk of bodily injury to another person.

STATE STATUTES IN FORCE THROUGHOUT THE UNITED STATES

CRIME #13: SEXUAL ASSAULT – Engaging in any sex act by force or against the will of the victim, especially when the victim has insufficient mental capacity to know the right or wrong of conduct in sexual matters, or is incapable of giving consent.

CRIME #14: AGE OF CONSENT – Performing deviate sexual conduct or any touching of a child under age 16, to arouse the sexual desire of the child or the adult.

CRIME #15: SODOMY - Knowingly committing any lewd or lascivious act upon or with the body of another person, to arouse or gratify lust, passion, or sexual desires.

CRIME #16: INDECENCY – Knowingly or intentionally engaging in deviate sexual conduct, or participating in or promoting hard-core sexual conduct appealing to prurient interests, for the sake of ensuring commercial gain or otherwise.

CRIME #17: SEXUAL GRATIFICATION OF A CHILD – Engaging in a sexual act to sexually arouse or gratify the adult or child, including masturbation or other sexual conduct.

CRIME #18: INVASION OF PRIVACY – Engaging in conduct which to an ordinary observer would appear to be sexual conduct, to sexually arouse or gratify the perpetrator.

CRIME #19: LEWDNESS – Committing any lewd act which would cause others to be alarmed or affronted, or would sexually stimulate an observer.

CRIME #20: PROCURING FOR EXPOSURE – Causing a child to expose genitals or pubic area for the purpose of sexual arousal or gratification.

CRIME #21: PROFANE CONDUCT – Engaging in indecent conduct in a public or private place.

CRIME #22: FORNICATION – Lewd or lascivious sexual acts involving persons not married to each other.

CRIME #23 ADULTERY – Sexual intercourse between two people, one or both of whom is married to a third person.

CRIME #24: RAPE – Intentionally or knowingly engaging in sexual conduct with any person without that person's consent.

CRIME #25: ABUSE OF POSITION OF TRUST OR AUTHORITY – Engaging in sexual conduct with a child where the adult is in a position of trust or authority over the child.

CRIME #26: PROFESSIONAL VOYEURISM – Examination of a person for the purpose of sexual arousal, gratification, or stimulation, including a mental health professional viewing a person's private anatomy.

CRIME #27: SEXUAL CONDUCT BY A PUBLIC SERVANT – Conduct of a sexual nature committed by a public servant acting under the color of his office.

CRIME #28: SEXUAL INTRUSION – Sexual contact or bodily intrusion of a child notwithstanding lack of apparent physical, mental, or emotional injury.

CRIME #29: INCEST – a felony in almost every state, including sexual intrusion on, or sexual contact with, a biological child, child by adoption, or stepchild.

CRIME #30: AGGRAVATED INCEST – Carnal knowledge of a juvenile, indecent behavior with juveniles, child pornography, crimes against nature, cruelty to juveniles, or touching of the body of a child, to arouse or satisfy sexual desires.

CRIME #31: PROSTITUTION – Engaging in sexual conduct with another person or paying another person to

engage in sexual conduct.

CRIME #32: AGGRAVATED PROSTITUTION – Engaging in sexual activity as a business.

CRIME #33: VISITING A LEWD PLACE: Visiting for immoral purposes a “bawdy” place, meaning a place used for lewdness or prostitution.

CRIME #34: PROCUREMENT – Profiting from or advancing prostitution by engaging in any conduct designed to institute or facilitate prostitution.

CRIME #35: CHILD PROSTITUTION – Promoting the prostitution of a child.

CRIME #36: PATRONIZING A PROSTITUTE – Paying a fee for another person to engage in sexual conduct.

CRIME #37: PROFITING FROM PROSTITUTION – Advancing or profiting from the prostitution of a child, especially through force or intimidation by coercive conduct.

CRIME #38: PANDERING – Soliciting a person to masturbate or have sexual conduct with a prostitute.

CRIME #38: PANDERING – Soliciting a person to masturbate or have sexual conduct with a prostitute.

CRIME #39: POSSESSION OF OBSCENITY – Possessing any obscene matter containing a visual reproduction of a child in any act of sexual excitement, genital nudity, touching of the genitals, or sexual contact between humans and animals.

CRIME #40: PURCHASE OF OBSCENE MATERIALS - Purchasing any visual or print medium in which minors are engaged in sexual conduct or in which minors are portrayed as observers of sexual conduct of contact.

CRIME #41: CHILD PORNOGRAPHY – Buying, procuring, possessing, or controlling any obscene material that has a minor as one of its participants, engaging in any type of sexual activity, nudity, bizarre violence, cruelty, brutality, human bodily functions of elimination, or bestiality.

CRIME #42: BESTIALITY – Performing any act of sexual gratification with any body member of an animal, or exhibiting, displaying, or performing of a child engaged in such an act or its simulation.

CRIME #43: OBSCENE COMMUNICATIONS – Faxing, telecommunicating, or writing lewd, lascivious, indecent, suggestive, or immoral messages to another person.

INTERNATIONAL LAW CURRENTLY IN FORCE:

CRIME #44: MEDICAL OR SCIENTIFIC EXPERIMENTATION (International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, U.N. DOC. A/6316; Article 7) – Torture, cruel and degrading treatment, and medical and scientific experimentation without free consent.
